



Acadian Federal Credit Union 2026 Scholarship Information Sheet

Eligibility: **Graduating High School Seniors and Current College/Technical School Students**

To be considered for the Acadian Federal Scholarship, the applicant must:

- Be a member in good standing with Acadian Federal Credit Union
- Be graduating from high school in the spring of 2026, or currently enrolled in undergraduate studies at an accredited college, university, or technical school or with plans to attend an accredited college, university or technical school full-time in the fall of 2026.
- Have maintained a 3.0 GPA based on 6 high school semesters or 1 most recent, completed college semester
- Complete an application and personal essay.

Acadian Federal applicants must be **active members at least 6 months**. Previous recipients of Acadian Federal program are not eligible to apply.

Application Package:

All applicants must submit an application package which includes:

- A completed application
- A current high school transcript or college transcript
- Two letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a teacher from your junior or senior year (only applies to high school seniors), or your current college professor or advisor
- A personal essay

Application Deadline:

Completed application packages must be submitted in credit union no later than 5:00 PM January 31, 2026 to:

Incomplete or late application packages will not be considered

Selection:

Each applicant's scholarship packet will be reviewed for completed information. Final selection of the scholarship recipient will be made through a random drawing at the February's Acadian Federal Credit Union's Board of Directors meeting.

Award:

Acadian Federal Credit Union will award a \$1,500 scholarship to the designated recipient at the credit union's annual meeting to be held in March 2026. The recipient can use the scholarship for any school related expenses. The recipient will receive \$1,500 in August for the fall semester of 2026. The check will be made payable directly to the recipient when proof of registration for that semester has been provided to the CEO.
